Hilton Head Island, SC, May 23, 2016 –Volunteers in Medicine Hilton Head Island (VIM) is pleased to announce that Nancy Sulek has been appointed Development Officer at the island’s free health care clinic.

A long-time islander, Ms. Sulek has lived on Hilton Head Island for 20 years. She has been actively involved as a volunteer with the island’s schools and various non-profits throughout the community. She has been a Troop Leader and served as Chair of a major Fundraiser for Girl Scouts of Eastern South Carolina, Death by Chocolate. She is a member of the Italian American Club of Hilton Head, a charitable service organization. The last two years, Ms. Sulek worked for WellTrackONE, a wellness company on Hilton Head as Senior Account Manager.

About Volunteers in Medicine Hilton Head Island

Volunteers in Medicine was established on Hilton Head Island in 1993 and now provides free medical, dental, mental health, vision and prescription drug care for those residents of the community who live and or work on Hilton Head or Daufuskie Island, earn less than 200% of federal poverty levels and are underinsured or uninsured. Last year, VIM treated more than 13,000 patients through nearly 33,000 patient visits and is the model for more than 70 free health clinics throughout the country. Funding is through grants and donations. VIM neither seeks nor accepts government support.

More than 700 volunteer physicians, nurses, dentists, chiropractors, social workers and lay persons manage 23 medical specialties and five disease management clinics for those patients with chronic disease such as diabetes and hypertension.
